Muhlenberg High School is located in central Berks County adjacent to the city of Reading (county seat), 50 miles northwest of Philadelphia, and 30 miles southwest of Allentown. Covering approximately 14 square miles, the school district includes Muhlenberg Township and the boroughs of Laureldale and Temple.

The school district is a suburban residential community with zoned commercial and industrial sections. The 2010 Federal Census statistics list the population at approximately 24,000. More than 3,700 students are enrolled in our schools.


