PennDOT cautions motorists, students to remember school bus safety tips

PennDOT reminds motorists to be alert for school buses and for children walking or biking to school.

Motorists in both directions must stop when a school bus has its red lights flashing and a stop arm extended. Violators of the state's school bus stopping law face a 60-day license suspension, five points on a driving record and a \$250 fine.

PennDOT also cautions motorists to watch for children who may dart into the street without looking and children playing around bus stops. Drivers should be extra alert when backing out of a driveway/garage. Last year in Pennsylvania there were 491 school bus crashes that caused 578 injuries.

Along with school bus safety, motorists also need to obey school zone speed limits, which are posted at 15 miles per hour.

PennDOT offers the following school bus safety tips to help kids be safe this year:

- Stay out of the street while waiting for the bus;
- Do not shout, yell, or sing while on the bus; it can distract the driver;
- Wait until the bus comes to a complete stop before exiting;
- Wear bright clothing and allow extra time to walk to the bus stop;
- Walk 10 giant steps in front of the bus so the driver can see you;
- Never retrieve anything that falls under the bus;
- Remain seated at all times while the bus is moving;
- Keep aisles clear and stow school bags under the seat; and
- Wait for the driver's signal before crossing in front of the bus. Be sure to look LEFT-RIGHT-LEFT to see that all cars have stopped.

School bus stopping law

- When you meet or overtake a stopped school bus with red signal lights flashing and stop arm extended, you **must stop**.
- When you approach an intersection where a school bus is stopped with red signal lights flashing and stop arm extended, you **must stop**.
- You **must stop** at least ten (10) feet away from the school bus.
 - You **must wait** until the red lights have stopped

flashing and the stop arm has been withdrawn before moving.

- **Do not move** until all the children have reached a place of safety.

Penalties

If you are convicted of violating Pennsylvania's School Bus Stopping Law you will receive all of the following penalties:

- 60-Day Driver's License Suspension
- Five (5) points on your driving record
- \$250 Fine

Muhlenberg Elementary selected for state foods program

Muhlenberg Elementary Center has been selected by the Pennsylvania Department of Education to participate in the Fresh Fruit and Vegetable Program (FFVP) for the 2006-07 school year.

The FFVP began as a pilot program authorized by Congress in 2002. The pilot program provided fresh fruits and vegetables in four states and an Indian Tribal Organization (ITO) for the 2002-03 school year for 207 schools. The purpose of the pilot was to increase fresh fruit and vegetable consumption for the students in the chosen schools. For the 2006-07 school year, 25 individual schools in Pennsylvania were selected for the FFVP. Muhlenberg Elementary Center is one of the 25 schools in Pennsylvania selected for this honorable grant.

The goals of the FFVP are to:

- create healthier school environments by providing healthier food choices
- expand the variety of fruits and vegetables offered to children
- increase children's fruit and vegetable consumption
- make a difference in children's lives to impact their present and future health.

Different types of fresh fruits and vegetables will be offered to Muhlenberg Elementary children every school day. In addition, all MEC children will receive nutrition education. Children will soon be bringing home nutrition education, activity sheets, recipes and more.

Two seniors honored

Two Muhlenberg seniors, David Ocasio and Noel San Juan, were recently honored by the CollegeBoard in their National Hispanic Recognition Program.

This program was initiated in 1983 to identify academically outstanding Hispanic students based on their PSAT/NMSQT test scores and grade point averages. David and Noel were among a group of 4700 students selected from a pool of 175,000 students.

“Hello Dolly” sets garner first place in Nationwide contest

Muhlenberg School District has a long and rich history of producing top notch plays and musicals. Muhlenberg Music Association kicks off annual patron drive

The MMA holds bake sales at all home football games in the baseball concession stand at the south end of the stadium near the middle school.
