	108.1. SUPPLEMENTAL MATERIALS
1. Authority	The Board shall permit the use of supplemental materials that implement, support and enrich the district's educational program.
2. Definition Pol. 108	Supplemental materials are materials selected by a teacher, in consultation with the building principal, that are used to enhance Board-approved textbooks and instructional materials for planned instruction. Supplemental materials shall include periodical articles, multimedia materials, maps, software, music, Internet-based content and other instructional materials. Supplemental materials are intended to be used in a single lesson/class and are not textbooks or instructional materials that would require Board adoption.
3. Delegation of Responsibility	<p>The Superintendent or designee shall establish administrative regulations for evaluating supplemental materials.</p> <p>The building principal shall be responsible for ensuring that all approved supplemental materials are appropriate and adhere to Board policy and administrative regulations.</p> <p>The teacher shall keep documentation of all supplemental materials used and shall be prepared to justify appropriate use of all supplemental materials.</p> <p>References:</p> <p>School Code – 24 P.S.
