Delegation of Responsibility</p>	<p>Where the activity requires completion of a physical examination or medical test as a condition of participation and the district offers such physical examination or medical test to district students, the district shall permit a student who is enrolled in a home education program to access such physical examination or medical test. The district shall publish the dates and times of such physical examination or medical test in a publication of general circulation in the district and on its publicly accessible web site.</p> <p>The building principal or designee shall ensure that home education students have access to information regarding the district’s extracurricular activities and interscholastic athletic programs.</p> <p>The building principal or designee shall receive and review verification from the parent/guardian that a student has met and continues to meet the established eligibility criteria for an extracurricular activity or interscholastic athletic program.</p> <p>The building principal or designee shall distribute information regarding eligibility criteria and student participation in extracurricular activities and interscholastic athletics to all affected by them.</p> <p>References:</p> <p>School Code – 24 P.S.
