210.2 MEDICAL ATTENTION FOR STUDENTS	
1. Purpose	The Board recognizes that students may require routine or emergency medical attention during the school day, during school-sponsored activities beyond school hours, while on district provided transportation, and when otherwise under the control or supervision of the district.
2. Delegation of Responsibility	<p>The Board directs the administration to develop administrative regulations and procedures for providing medical attention to students.
