In addition, students are a valuable resource whose contributions can aid and benefit the programs of the schools.</p> <p>The Board directs that students be invited to participate in activities appropriate to their maturity and competency, leading to administrative decision-making.</p> <p>Suggestions for improvement may be offered by any student, provided they are of a constructive nature and contribute toward the realization of the district's educational goals.</p> <p>The building principal shall develop rules to implement this policy which:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Provide for submission, consideration, and response to constructive student suggestions. 2. Designate the manner by which students shall be selected for participation in school matters. 3.
