<p>1. Authority</p> <p>SC 510</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">321. POLITICAL ACTIVITIES</p> <p>The Board recognizes and encourages the right of administrative, professional and support employees, as citizens, to engage in political activity. However, district property and district time, paid for by taxpayers, may not be used for political purposes by district employees when performing assigned duties.</p> <p>Employees shall not engage in political activities during assigned work hours on property under the jurisdiction of the Board.</p> <p>The following situations are exempt from the provisions of this policy:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Discussion and study of politics and political issues when applicable to the curriculum and appropriate to classroom studies.</li><li>2. Conduct of student elections and connected campaigning.</li><li>3. Conduct of employee representative elections.</li><li>4. Do not campaign on school property on behalf of any candidate for local, state, or national office during school time and/or at school-sponsored activities.</li></ol> <p>References:</p> <p>School Code – 24 P.S.
