

Muhlenberg High School is located in central Berks County adjacent to the city of Reading (county seat), 50 miles northwest of Philadelphia, and 30 miles southwest of Allentown. Covering approximately 14 square miles, the school district includes Muhlenberg Township and the boroughs of Laureldale and Temple.

The school district is a suburban residential community with zoned commercial and industrial sections. A small portion of the district is open space used for agricultural purposes. The 2000 Federal Census statistics list the population at approximately 20,000. More than 3,400 students are enrolled in our schools.

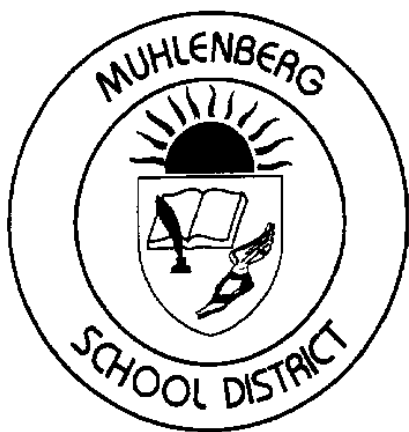

**Muhlenberg High School** is a comprehensive public high school with an approximate student population of 950 (grades 10 through 12). The school year consists of four, 45-day marking periods with graduation in June.

**Curriculum** College preparatory, career preparatory, and career - technical programs are available to all students. Student academic needs are met through Advanced Placement, honors, college, and career level courses. Special education programs are also available for that identified population.

**Advanced Placement Courses** are offered in Art History, Studio Art, English Literature/Composition, Government, Calculus, Statistics, Biology, Chemistry, and Physics B.

#### CLASS RANK

Class rank is computed at the end of each grade. Advanced Placement and Honors courses as well as Advanced Biology, Advanced Chemistry, and Advanced Physics are weighted in determining class rank. All other courses are calculated using the following grade weights: A = 4.0, A- = 3.5, B = 3.0, B- = 2.5, C = 2.0, C- = 1.5, D = 1.0, F = 0.0, F1 = -1.0, and F2 = -2.0. Ranking is based on all subjects that receive letter grades except music performance classes. The student with the highest grade point average (based on final grades only) will be ranked first.

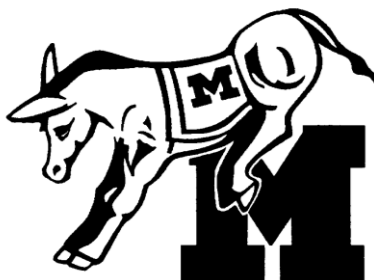
