Summer School Program



The Muhlenberg Board of School Directors has approved the operation of a high school (grades 9 – 12) Summer School Program beginning Monday, June 20, 2011, and ending Thursday, July 21, 2011, with the Independence Day Holiday being observed on Monday, July 4, 2011. The program will include academic subjects listed on page 3. **NOTE: SUMMER SCHOOL WILL OPERATE MONDAY THROUGH THURSDAY. We will not operate on Fridays during the summer months.**

Remedial Academic Program

Purposes

- A. Recover subject failures and receive credit
- B. Reduce class size for upcoming school year
- C. Improve Graduation Rate
- D. Enrichment

Time Schedule

Five-Week Courses – 150 minutes daily (20 class meetings) = 50 hours total. The first course will be conducted from 8:00 a.m. – 10:30 a.m.; second course 10:30 a.m. – 1:00 p.m.

Note: Students who enroll in required make-up courses must attend all sessions. **(Parents who have planned vacation between June 20 and July 21 should not register their child since requests for time off from summer school will not be granted.)** Any students that are absent/tardy more than two classes without a doctor's excuse will be dropped from the course. **Any student dropped from a course for attendance or behavioral issues will not have their money refunded.**

Location – All summer school classes will be held at Muhlenberg High School.

Eligibility – Residents who have been enrolled in grades 9 through 12 (2010-2011).

Course Tuition - \$150.00 per course

Number of Courses – A student is allowed to take a maximum of two (2) remedial courses.

Minimum Enrollments – 12 students

Transportation – Will *not* be provided by the Muhlenberg School District. This is the responsibility of the students and their parents.

Registration – Will be held in the Main Office of Muhlenberg High School. Return the attached form as soon as possible. Registration deadline is Friday, June 17, 2011. Absolutely no registration will be accepted after Friday, June 17, 2011. **Note: Students may not take summer school courses at another institution if the course is being offered at Muhlenberg High School. If a course is not being offered at Muhlenberg High School and you wish to take it at another school, approval must be granted by administration. No courses will be accepted without administrative approval.**

Summer School Regulations for All Programs

Attendance – Students must attend every day of summer school to comply with the minimum requirement of 48 hours to receive full credit for a course. If a student is absent, his/her absence must be covered by a doctor's/parent's note. Students will be permitted two (2) excused absences. Once a student has reached a 3rd absence, they will be dropped from the course. **(Tuition will not be refunded.)**

Lateness – Lateness is unacceptable. If a student accumulates a total of three (3) tardies, they will be dropped from the course, and **tuition will not be refunded.**

Student Dress – The Muhlenberg High School dress code will be enforced. Administration shall be the final judge of appropriate dress.

Discipline – The Muhlenberg High School discipline code will be enforced. Any student in violation of the code may be expelled from summer school. If a student is removed from a class for disciplinary reasons, it will result in a recorded absence.
