each grade level will win a \$5.00 gift certificate to the Book Fair who are selected as the winners.



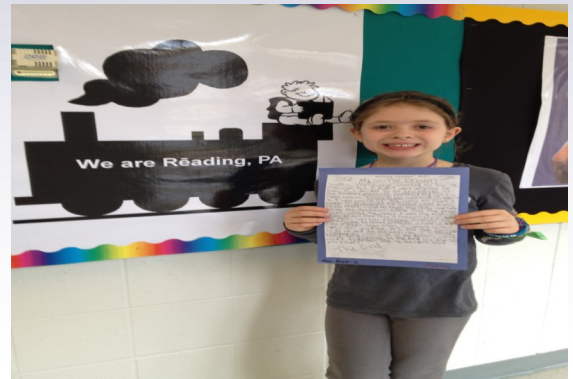
