

Hello MHS Families,

Starting Wednesday, January 3rd, MHS will be administering the Winter Keystone Exams.

The testing dates are as follows:

Thursday, Jan 4	Literature - Module 2	7:40 - 9:55
Friday, Jan 5	Algebra - Module 1	7:40 - 9:55
Monday, Jan 8	Algebra - Module 2	7:40 - 9:55
Tuesday, Jan 9	Biology - Module 1	7:40 - 9:55
Wednesday, Jan 10	Biology - Module 2	7:40 - 9:55

Each student who is scheduled to take an exam will be contacted by their teacher, counselor, or Dr. Ciccarelli. In addition, there is a list of students who will be testing posted outside of the main office.

Notes:

- Students that are testing will report to school as normal and will test from 7:40 - 9:55 am.
- **Testing begins promptly at 7:40 am.**
- **Non-Test Takers** should report to school at 7:40 am **OR** report at 9:55 am, providing transportation on their own.
- **Non-Test Takers** who report to school at 7:40 am are to report to the auditorium for study hall until testing concludes for the day.

Please be aware that all buses will be running at their normal pick up times. We will not be running a separate pickup schedule for the 10:00 am start. Any student who needs school transportation will be picked up at their normal time and location. Students not taking the Keystone Exams and using Muhlenberg transportation will have a study hall in the auditorium until the conclusion of testing at 9:55 am.

Students who have their own transportation and are not testing can arrive anytime prior to 9:55 am. Students not taking the exam who arrive later than 10:00 am to their second period class will be marked tardy to school.

Student breakfast will be served to any student who arrives from 7:15 am to 7:40 am. If your child eats breakfast at school each day and is not scheduled to take the exam, they will need to arrive before 7:40 am in order to eat.

Morning CTC Students:

- Non-Test-Takers should go to the CTC as usual.
- Students that are testing will test at the High School from 7:40 - 9:55 am.
- Students will report to the Auditorium from 10:00 - 10:28 am, eat lunch in the MHS cafeteria from 10:32 - 11:00 am, and then return to the Auditorium from 11:04-11:44 am. At 11:48 am, students will resume their normal schedule.

Tips for preparing for the test:

- Students should get a good night's sleep before the test.
- Students should eat a healthy breakfast.
- Students should wear comfortable clothes.
- Being on time to school is very important.
- Students should maintain a positive attitude.
- Please review the cell phone policy provided by PDE on the school website.
