WELCOME BACK!



Every classroom at MEC this year will have a 7 tier clip chart for classroom management.


Each day our children will start the day READY TO LEARN. Working hard will earn them a clip up to EXCELLENT EFFORT, WAY TO GO or even SUPER STUDENT. Maintaining SUPER STUDENT five times can earn them a jewel on their clip and a HALL OF FAME certificate.

If a child receives a warning for a behavior, their clip will move down to MAKE BETTER CHOICES. Repetitive bad behavior choices can move to TEACHER'S CHOICE or PARENT CONTACT.

Check in with your child's teacher to find out how well your student is climbing the clip chart.

BUCKET FILLING

Bucket filling at MEC recognizes good actions and deeds that our students do for each other. Each classroom will have a bucket and cotton balls that represent a good deed. An example of a good deed could be helping a student carry books or inviting a friend to sit with them at lunch.
