Position Paper

A position paper presents one side of an arguable opinion about an issue. The goal of a position paper is to convince the audience that your opinion is valid and defensible. Your job is to take one side of the argument and persuade your audience that you have wellfounded knowledge of the topic being presented. It is important to support your argument with evidence to ensure the validity of your claims.



The Thesis Statement

- A thesis is a one-sentence statement about your topic. It's an assertion about your topic, something you claim to be true.
- Think about what your readers want or need to know. Then write a sentence stating what will be the central idea of your paper.
