Muhlenberg High School Graduation Modified Graduation Ceremony June 18, 2020 at 10:00 AM

- o On Thursday June 18, 2020 the Muhlenberg High School graduation ceremony begins at 10 AM.
- o Rain date for the ceremony will be Friday June 19, 2020.
- Students need to arrive in one car per family and with their cap and gown on.
- Vehicles may not be larger than a traditional parking spot on our campus.
- Students should follow school dress code guidelines for their cap and gown apparel.
- o Students will be broken down alphabetically by guidance counselor.
 - o A through F (Work) reporting to high school parking lot by 9:45 AM at the latest but not before 9:30 AM
 - o A through F ceremony will occur from 10:00 AM to 11:30 AM
 - o G through O (Hendel) reporting to high school by 11:45 AM
 - o G through O ceremony will occur from 12:00 PM to 1:30 PM
 - o P through Z (Will) reporting to high school by 1:45 PM
 - o P through Z ceremony will occur from 2:00 PM to 4:00 PM
 - Student overflow traffic will be directed to the back parking lot until their designated time frame.

Directions:

- Staff will direct students and families to a specific designated parking space in a specific row where they will park and turn off their car.
- o Cars will be socially distanced for safety one space apart.
- Certain areas for parking will be marked and roped off as areas near the stage will be for graduation viewing.
- Students will be given a pre-printed index card by their alpha school counselor list with their diploma name when entering the lot parking lot.
- When cars are settled near the stage, students will be instructed to line up on the side of the stage with their index card in hand while maintaining social distance.



- o Students will walk up a steps individually and hand their name card to Mr. Mish at the top of the steps.
- o Once their name is announced, they will cross the stage, be greeted by Dr. Macharola and receive their diploma cover from Ms. Morris.
- o Upon exiting the stage near Mr. Schaeffer, Purdon Photography will take a picture of each graduate with their diploma cover.
- Students will receive a 5X7 photo from Purdon, complimentary of the school, at a later date when completed.
- o After the photo is taken, students will directly return to their car and be guided to exit around the music wing and pool entrance, behind the school and continue to the bus canopy area.
- o At the bus canopy area, students will receive their graduation packets.
- Student are then are free to exit on to Sharp Avenue as Muhlenberg High School graduates.
- o If families wish to have a photo opportunity with a Muhlenberg back drop, a photo booth area will be set up in the MEC and CE COLE parking lots.

Others:

- o For safety purposes, students must have a mask worn during the entire time except for their time to walk across the stage, receive their diploma and get their picture taken.
- o Staff workers and volunteers will park in the smaller lot near CE COLE and the Blue Center and walk across the path the high school.
