A. Berks County Intermediate Unit - Mr. Randall R. Madara

Mr. Madara said a copy of *What Happened at the BCIU Board Meeting* was included in the Board packet which provided an update.

Mrs. Mengle said they did not have a meeting yet this month; but, from last month's meeting, the RMCTC is still virtual.

C. Berks County Tax Collection Committee - Mr. Shane M. Mathias, CPA

Mr. Mathias said that there was a meeting on October 29th via Zoom. He said they gave an update on the new tax software which seems to be on schedule. The Board passed a resolution making it mandatory for an employer with more than fifteen employees to file online with this new system, effective January 1, 2021. Mr. Mathias said they are looking into some of the collections and distributions due to COVID-19 since the collections are into the second quarter of 2020. They reported that things were not as bad as they projected, but collections are decreased overall. This is not specific to Muhlenberg.

Comments/Questions/Concerns:

Mr. Lupia asked at what point would the Board be able to meet in person in the next couple of months. He said the meetings could be held in a location where the Board could be spaced apart. *Mr.* Lupia said they meet face-to-face at the RMCTC. He said meeting via Zoom is bologna and the Board cannot let the virus control them. *Mrs.* Mengle said most of the RMCTC Committee Members are given a choice to be in person or via Zoom. She said she prefers Zoom because she must be careful since she is working and she tries to stay home as much as possible. *Mr.* Nelson said the Board should wait until the number of cases come down. He said there was one hundred plus new cases yesterday in Berks County; the numbers are going in the wrong direction.

Mr. Hoffmaster asked how many people in the District have been affected by the virus. Dr. Macharola said there were eighty-five staff members – almost one fifth of the entire staff has been either exposed to COVID-19, tested positive, had symptoms or had to quarantine. He said it is an incredible challenge – eighty-five employees, but students are not in school. Dr. Macharola said had students been in the buildings, school would have been shut down for five and half weeks. He said it is a very serious time in the state, especially in Berks County. The numbers are sky rocketing. The Department of Health and PDE have not mandated, but they have strongly recommended that the District remain virtual. Dr. Macharola said it has been a real challenge and one life lost is one too many. He said he does not think it should be taken lightly. No one wants the students back to school as much as he does, but he wants everyone safe.
