## **CAP & GOWN DISTRIBUTION – during all three lunch periods.**

You will need your payment at that time. - **\$24.50 - Cash preferred - make checks payable to Herff-Jones**  
(include name/address on check)

1. Caps and gowns will be distributed from the lobby concession stand.  
You may pick up your cap and gown during your lunch period.
2. The gowns, which are made of a light-weight nylon material, should be pressed. **DO NOT USE A HOT IRON.**
3. The girls' gowns are gold. Girls should wear light-colored shoes and light-colored dresses with their gowns.
4. The boys' gowns are blue. Boys should wear dark shoes, dark trousers, light-colored shirt, and **dark tie** (is a **must**) with their gowns. T-shirts and sneakers for boys are not proper attire.
5. Tassels should be looped twice around the button on top of cap and should hang over the left temple.  
Be careful; tassels are easily lost and cannot be replaced.

## **CLASS PICTURE and BACCALAUREATE REHEARSAL**

**7:15 a.m. – 12 noon** (*Please be prompt*)

1. All seniors participating in the commencement program must report to the gymnasium by **7:15 a.m.** for the class picture at 7:30 a.m.\*

**\*Caps and gowns will be worn for the picture.**

**Boys will need a light-colored shirt, dark tie, shoes and pants. T-shirts and sneakers are not proper attire.**

**Girls will need light-colored shoes.**

**Lack of proper attire will result in students not being allowed in the picture.**

2. The commencement line up will begin immediately after the class picture is taken. Please plan to remain until 12 noon (if necessary). Leave building promptly after conclusion of rehearsal.
  - a) The commencement processional order will be posted on the wall outside the gym.  
Look for your name and memorize your number before the class picture is taken.
  - b) Girls should consider wearing the shoes they will wear for commencement.  
This will permit them to become accustomed to walking in them.
3. Baccalaureate Rehearsal - Seniors planning to participate in the Baccalaureate program will remain in the gym following the commencement line up practice. At this time, all student speakers for Baccalaureate and Commencement will rehearse.

1. Seniors participating in the graduation ceremony must report to MHS main lobby by 8:30 a.m. Transportation will be provided to the Sovereign Center for practice.
2. Admit tickets for commencement will be distributed at the conclusion of commencement rehearsal.
3. Seniors participating, assemble at Sovereign Center, Reading, PA at 6:00 p.m. with caps, gowns, and appropriate attire.
4. Corsages will be provided for the girls and boutonnieres for the boys.
5. After the program, graduates should report to their homeroom table to pick up their graduation packet which includes their diploma.
