Dear Muhlenberg School District Families:



This pandemic has required everyone to work within rapidly changing circumstances. Our top priority is keeping students and our school communities safe. Governor Wolf announced that all schools will remain closed until further notice, as we work to mitigate the spread of COVID-19 and protect the health of all our Pennsylvanians.

With this in mind, our goal is to provide a reasonable and appropriate education while operating in good faith. Our district has begun the process to move from Enrichment Opportunities to Virtual Learning. The following is our timeline to provide students and families with the specifics of Virtual Learning:

- Wednesday, April 8, 2020 distribution of Technology will occur at each building. Building principals will be contacting you with specific times and locations for pick up.
- Thursday, April 9, 2020 will be the first day of Virtual Learning as well as the first day of the 4th Quarter.
- Teachers will be communicating with our students the guidelines/grading of their Continuity of Education Plan.
 - There will be one (1) activity/assessment per week
 - The time for each activity/assessment will be 30-120 minutes per week, per course/subject
 - The continuity of education will be communicated one week at a time
 - Each teacher will have virtual office hours for students if the need of help arises
