Muhlenberg School District Behind-The-Wheel Driver Education Re-Opening Health and Safety Plan and Guidelines

The instructor will notify parents via telephone the following health and safety guidelines:

Parent and Students

- While driving, student must wear a mask at all times.
- Student must have their temperature checked before every driving lesson. The temperature cannot be over 100.4 degrees.
- If the student feels sick, please contact the driver education instructor ahead of time.
- There will be no food or drink allowed in the vehicle by the student or driver education instructor.
- Students cannot enter the Muhlenberg High School building at any time.
- The driver education instructor will explain each student's behind-the-wheel schedule, fee, location, etc.
- The driver education instructor will explain there will be no license testing until PENNDot opens their testing center for testing directed by the state.

Instructor

- The driver education instructor will have his temperature checked prior to the daily instruction shift.
- The driver education instructor will be wearing a N95 mask at all times.
- The vehicle will be disinfected and cleaned before each student and after the last student is completed for the day.
- Hand sanitizer will be in the vehicle.
- The driver education instructor will shower and change of clothes before entering his personnel vehicle.
