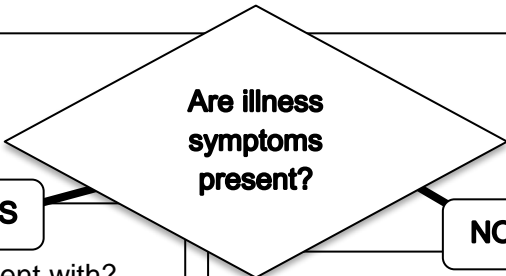


**Muhlenberg School District Health Services**  
**Visit guidelines for students and staff who feel ill during school hours**

The student/staff member coming into the health room *must wear a mask and/or face shield*. The Health Services nurse will stand behind the plexiglass and will ask the student/staff member what his/her presenting symptoms are and check the student's/staff member's temperature.

**Health Services staff will wear a mask, face shield and other PPE as per Universal Precautions standards.**



**YES**

Does the student/staff present with?  
**One of these symptoms:**  
**New onset of cough or shortness of breath** (for students/staff with chronic allergic/asthmatic cough: a change in their cough from their baseline)  
**Fever of 100.0 or higher**  
**Difficulty breathing**  
**OR at least 2 of these symptoms:**  
 Headache  
 Sore throat  
 Chills, shivering  
 Runny nose/congestion  
 Muscle pain  
 Loss of sense of taste or smell  
 Gastrointestinal symptoms- nausea, vomiting, or diarrhea

\*If student/staff member is having difficulty breathing or shortness of breath, call 911

**NO**

If the student/staff member presents to the Health Services for:  
 Injuries  
 Chronic care  
 Daily medications

**Note:** Respiratory exacerbations should be treated per student/staff medical plan. Nebulizer treatments will be done outside the building and only in the event of an extreme emergency.

**NO**

The student/staff member must continue to wear his/her mask in Health Services

Once care has been completed the student/staff member must wash hands prior to leaving and the area used by the student/staff member will be disinfected.

- The student/staff member must continue to wear mask and will be triaged to an isolation area.
- Students will be 6 feet apart from each other and monitored closely until they have been picked up by parent/guardian.
- A COVID-19 Monitoring Sheet must be completed for each student/staff member presenting with illness symptoms
- Parents/guardian should be notified promptly, that their child will need to go home. Once the student has been picked up, the area must be disinfected.
- \*If at any point in time the student is having difficulty breathing or shortness of breath, call 911.
